### ADDENDUM #1 Questions and Answers

Addendum #1 for Valley Ride/Valley Regional Transit Request for Proposal (RFB 2019-01-29 CNG Compressor) is hereby made part of the project requirements and contract documents for the referenced project. Please note, failure to acknowledge this Addendum does not relieve you from fulfilling the Addendum requirements.

The following questions have been addressed and are now part of the procurement process:

1. For each of the compressors that the bidder will work on for this contract, it will not be operational for three days and two nights. Is this your understanding?

Yes, the system will need to remain operational with at least one compressor functioning throughout the project schedule, but one at a time, the units being worked on will have to be taken out of service. Communication will need to occur as to when the required shutdown will occur so that additional fueling can be completed by operations as needed prior to the shutdown.

2. Upon review of Exhibit C, titled "Insurance Requirements", with respect to paragraph 3, Commercial General Liability, "... (including the tort liability of another assumed in a business contract). ...." please clarify that the intent of this wording is not to provide coverage for the liability of another. Please define "another" assumed in a business contract.

Coverage applies only to a particular type of assumed liability—the liability that is assumed is the tort liability of the indemnitee, generally for the indemnitee's negligence to others.

3. As respects Exhibit F, paragraph g, "Insurance: Required Coverage:", regarding the statement, "... The Insurance Coverage as required below and shall cause Valley Regional Transit to be a named insured on all policies (except professional liability). Contractor shall provide Proof of Insurance to VALLEY REGIONAL TRANSIT prior to award. Proof of Insurance shall to include an additional insured endorsement." Please confirm that additional insured status is acceptable. Yes, that is acceptable.

4. What is the definition for a small business under FAR Section 19.001 (Page 18 RFP Form, "Certificate of Small Business Status").

There is really no written answer for the definition of a small business but you can use the link below and use your NAICS code, to determine if your organization qualifies.
