As a material inducement to VRT entering into this Agreement, Service Provider represents and warrants that they are a Service Provider of first class work and services and Service Provider is experienced in performing the work and services contemplated herein and, in light of such status and experience, Service Provider covenants that it shall follow the highest professional standards in performing the work and services required hereunder and that all materials will be of good quality, fit for the purpose intended. For purposes of this Agreement, the phrase “highest professional standards” shall mean those standards of practice recognized by one or more first-class firms performing similar work under similar circumstances.

This project is for a traditional 5310 purchase of service in portions of Ada and Canyon Counties. The grant funds will contribute towards the cost of transportation services for persons that are age 65 and older and persons with disabilities. The Service Provider will be a private, non-profit agency that will offer and provide effective mobility options in an efficient manner. Service Provider acknowledges that it is a sub-recipient Service Provider of 5310 Acquisition of Service grant funds received by VRT.
